A compass rose

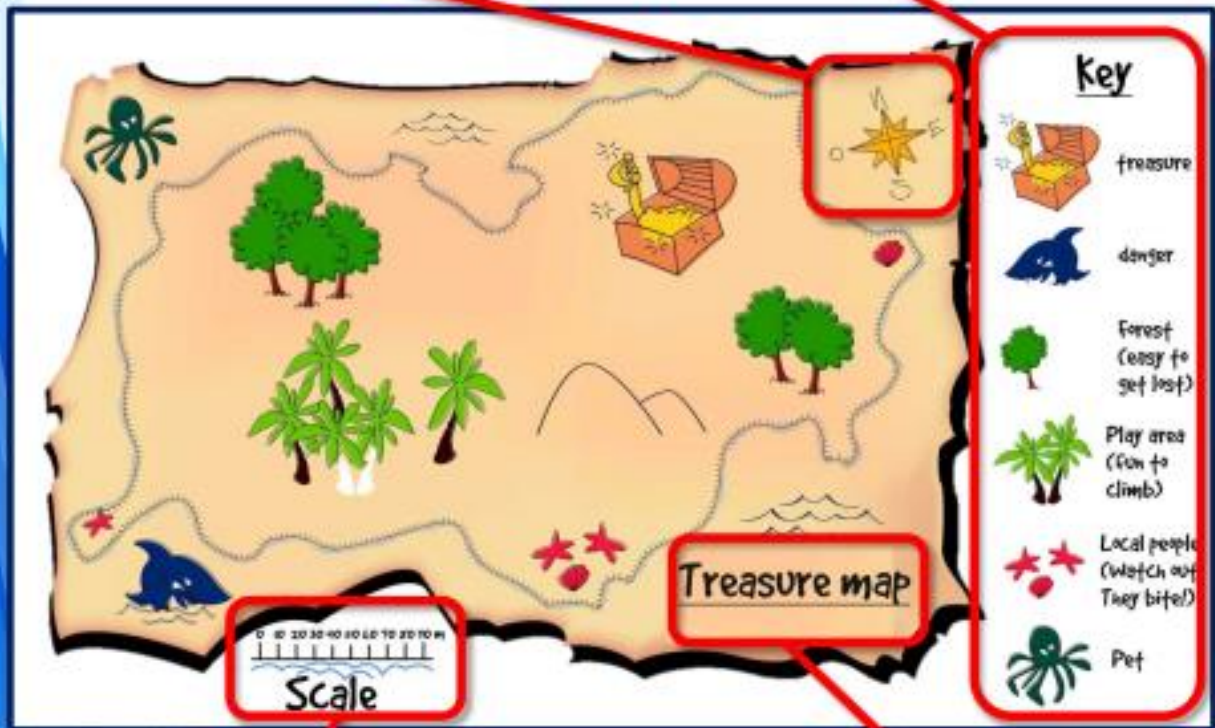
Why do we need a new one?
