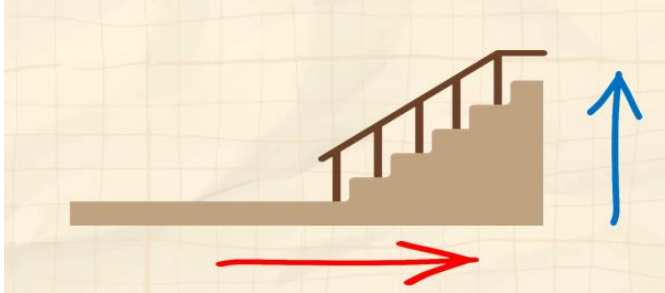

TASK: This week

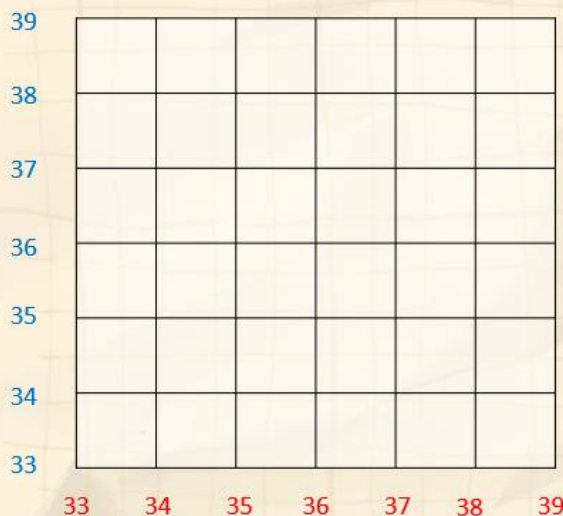
KEY VOCABULARY: (This should be discussed with an adult at home and used in your home learning if possible)
