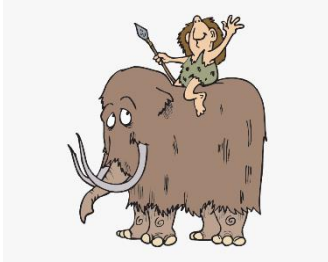


Year 3 Home Learning Opportunities

Design & build your own version of Stone Henge (you can use different resources such as lego, wooden blocks or even biscuits!) - take pictures of your creation.

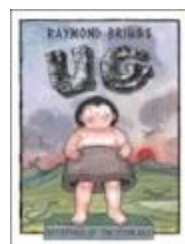
Create a visitor guide to Stone Henge. Include pictures and facts.

Compare the lengths and heights of different prehistoric animals.

Find out about prehistoric musical instruments and record your research.

Use caves as a starting point for learning about light and shadows (you could make shadow puppets of prehistoric animals).
